I was fascinated you very early on we would often walk locally to see thorn and collect their leaves.

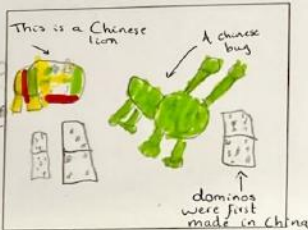
